- All dresses are designed to fall below the knee
- Jane & Marilyn's designs have been created with the Season's events, and dress codes, in mind
- Most of Jane & Marilyn's designs have versatile, flattering three guarter length sleeves
- The Jane & Marilyn collection retails for between £595.00 and £845.00
